## This is why we have the Walk for Paws



We first met Bigby when he was in a crowded shelter with few resources, and he had a badly dislocated shoulder. The only option for him was amputation since they did not have the funds for him to see a specialist, or to pay for surgery that could possibly save his leg. With short legs and a long body, amputation of a front limb was, literally, not an option he could live with.

His prognosis unknown, this sweet boy desperately needed a safe place to stay while his leg was evaluated and treated. We put out a plea for help, and Eric and Meta stepped for-

ward. They have two beagle mix girls, Teela and Pearl, adopted from our county shelter. After hearing about a complicated surgery Teela had undergone, we were thrilled to have a foster family capable of dealing with complex surgical procedures. That was just what Bigby needed!

But when we took Bigby for his initial surgery, it was bad news. Not only was his shoulder dislocated, it was also fractured and the surrounding tissue was so damaged that the surgery was cut short and Bigby was sent back to his foster home. It appeared he had been the victim of a very traumatic injury, and his recovery was not going to be a simple one. His orthopedist consulted other specialists as far away as Europe, but once again, despite our best efforts, amputation looked likely.

Frequent physical therapy appointments were prescribed to loosen up the shoulder joint in preparation for further surgery. To make a very long story short, this dog amazed everyone, including his surgeon, by making an incredible recovery. Without surgery! He and his foster parents worked very hard exercising him and attending many vet appointments over a long course of time. Their dedication, all the positive thoughts sent out to Bigby, plus the fact that he is simply an extraordinary dog all combined to make his story a great success.

You might have guessed that after spending all this time and effort on him, his foster family became his permanent one

Dad says "He just has an amazing personality - everyone falls in love with him. I can't tell you how happy we are to have this little guy. Our older girl Teela loved him from the start, but Pearl held back. But now she purposely stirs him up, and they run around and roll around like crazy. Sometimes all three of them will get into it, and we just have this big mass of grumbling posturing dogs having a great time together. He's just a great dog. No accidents, and very well behaved. In fact, he's been a good influence on our girls. Somehow he has managed to reduce the number of accidents they were having in the house, which is a wel-come improvement. He's very bright too, learns very quickly, and he hasn't gotten into any-thing he shouldn't in a good long when you came across him in that shelter. Thank you and the Animal Advocates for finding him and rescuing him!"

Helping great dogs, especially those who are out of options, is one of our main goals. We can't help all of them, but with donations from the Walk For Paws, we help as many as we can.

So in honor of Bigby, Eric, Meta, and Pearl, and in loving memory of Teela, we ask you to join us at the Walk this year to help us save lives, one step at a time.
